- **Deadline is Friday October 9, 2026.**
- Sign up on the IDCC website at www.ingersollcurlingclub.com and either e-transfer your payment or drop by the club during Opening Week (hours listed below) to make your payment.
- After October 9th there is a \$50.00 late fee.

Payment

- Membership fees may be paid by cheque, debit or credit card at the club or by e-transfer.
- **E-transfer payments.**
 - Interac® e-Transfer payments: If you have not used this process before but do use online banking, follow the instructions on your bank's electronic web pages. The email account to send your money to is info@ingersollcurlingclub.ca and there is no need to use a security question. This account has Direct Deposit. In the *Message to Contact* enter your name and membership type. Should you have questions about how to do this, your banking institution can assist you.
- Membership payment plan is splitting the membership into 3 equal payments due on October 9th, November 9th and December 9th, 2026.
