- **Deadline is Friday October 10, 2025.**
- Sign up on the **IDCC website at www.ingersollcurlingclub.com** and either e-transfer your payment or drop by the club during Opening Week (hours listed below) to make your payment.
- After October 10th there is a \$50.00 late fee.

Payment

- Membership fees may be paid by cheque, debit, credit card at the club or by e-transfer.
- **E-transfer payments.**
 - Interac® e-Transfer payments: If you have not used this process before but do use online banking, follow the instructions on your bank's electronic web pages. The email account to send your money to is **info@ingersollcurlingclub.ca** and there is no need to use a security question. This account has Direct Deposit. In the *Message to Contact* enter your name and membership type. Should you have questions about how to do this, your banking institution can assist you.
- Membership payment plan is splitting the membership into 3 equal payments due on October 10th, November 10th and December 10th, 2025.
